



Student Staff Device Zone - Best Practices Checklist

This document serves as a final checklist of the steps required in order to set up a personal device to connect to Wolf Creek mobile networks. Commonly asked questions can be reviewed at: <http://www.wolfcreek.ab.ca/cgkfaq>

IMPORTANT → Ensure that all of the following steps have been completed:

- I have read and understand the Wolf Creek Public Schools Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) and the supplemental school based policies regarding the use of technology
- I have signed the SSDZ application form (student and parent/guardian) and returned it to the school
- I have updated my operating system with any recent security patches
- I have installed and/or updated my antivirus software definitions (must be less than 1 week old) (NOTE: many free virus protection programs are available but may not be the best option. You can find a list of virus protection programs that CyberGateKeeper works with at: <http://www.wolfcreek.ab.ca/cgkagent>)
- I have completed a pre-scan from home using the tool at: <http://www.wolfcreek.ab.ca/cgkagent>
- I have downloaded and installed the **CyberGateKeeper Agent** software from <http://www.wolfcreek.ab.ca/cgkagent>
- I have made **ALL** the necessary changes (required for the operating system that I have) to my **Wireless Network Connection** outlined in the **SSDZ Connection Instructions** document (link below) <http://www.wolfcreek.ab.ca/TechInfo/Technology%20Docs/SSDZ%20Connection%20Instructions.pdf>
- I understand that I will be automatically disconnected from the SSDZ network if I launch any restricted software that is not permitted in Wolf Creek Public Schools such as: Skype, Limewire, BitTorrent or any other restricted software
- I have entered my username and password correctly using the **wolfcreek** preface in front of my personal username

Laptop Configurations
